

**CDROB Committee Up-date on actions concerning a Brundall PROW
(Public right of Way)**

An update on progress on Brundall Parish Council's request to seek for Brundall villagers a new Public Right of Way (PROW) to the River Yare.

The following actions have been taken:

1. Notice served on all Berth holders and Landowners within the Brundall Bay Marina site. Letters with information about the Council's intent to create 2 new paths in addition to the existing paths were sent via recorded delivery on 27th August.
2. A package of information has been submitted (on 28.8.19) to Kathryn Webb at Norfolk County Council (NCC). This includes:
 - a) A PROW Application (Form 1) applying for an Order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a Footpath (2 Paths);
 - b) A letter explaining the reasons for application;
 - c) Co-ordinates and Application Map Ordinance survey map (not less than 1/25,000) of footpath, which has drawn on the application route;
 - d) Form 2 – an example of notice served on owner occupiers;
 - e) Form 3 – a completed Certificate of Service (with date of Service) of Notice on Owners and Occupiers.
 - f) Twenty-two signed 'User Evident Forms' (each with a signed map – refer to example below) from those who have walked the footpath.
3. Kathryn Webb is in receipt of the PROW forms so this process is now officially within Norfolk County Council's control. NCC will be conducting consultations with stakeholders which will include all stakeholder groups, such as the Ramblers Association.
4. Notices have now been placed on relevant sites near to and at Brundall Marina Bay. Here we also await any 'actions' and/or feedback from relevant parties.
5. Information on the project will be put into the public domain (once Parish Councillors have been informed).

The present Public Right of Way ('footpath') from the Brundall Riverside Road is highlighted red on map above. The request for a new public right of way footpath is from the intersection of an existing right of way (red) route (co-ordinates from TG 32841 07762 East 632841 North 307759), continuing to East Hills Café Bistro and taking two North East path routes to the River Yare. The 'two' (combined) right of way footpath routes have been identified on Map (as Green and Purple). The Routes and approximates co-ordinates are as follows:
