RW118	Minutes of Meeting 14th August 2023 It was resolved by a unanimous decision to accept the minutes as an accurate record.

RW122	Public Participation: A resident spoke of her interest in the bin provision.	
RW123	Update on Parish Council Matters and other organisations Parish Council Sports Hub – A contractor has been appointed for the pavilion who is H Smith and Sons (Honingham) Ltd. There is a pre-start meeting scheduled for 12 October. The being properly managed with one area of the site needing some attention regarding hedging. The social media comms subgroup is still into the trial period and so far, the posts have been well received with more questions being raised. The Parish Partnerships funding stream is now open, and the road safety group is currently looking at options. 2 new SAM2 devices are up in the village, recording data which is being used to also send to the police and any public who would like to see it. Land Management – the Committee are helping with the hedging and planting at the 3G pitch site and to look at the eastern fence due to boundary issues. Cremers Bridge – there are planning application issues that need to be resolved – relating to traffic impact and ecology. Update on Yare Valley Churches matters.	

	No report was received. Richard reported that the vacancy has been re-advertised and applications should be submitted by 23 October with interviews scheduled of 24 November. Update on Brundall Memorial Hall matters. No report received. Brundall School No report was received.	
RW124	Brundall Village Park The cost of the A106 deed of variation has been approved, to ensure the land is transferred directly to the parish council. The reserved matters application is now out for consultation.	
RW125	Brundall Countryside Park Cllr Savory is collating the results of the data from the survey to find out if the village wants the Council to apply to purchase the land. There were 437 respondents and out of those, 96% are in favour of this.	
RW126	Report on Brundall dog bins Land Management are investigating a new bin in Brundall Countryside Park. A bigger bin is needed on Berryfields. Jack would like to look holistically at the whole village bin provision and would welcome any input before he submits a report with costings*. Cllrs suggested looking at the Dales jw The Street, Brundall Memorial Hall, Station Road. A resident also suggested the top of Golf Links Road, and Braydeston Hills (not Brundall). Jack reported that the weather seems to affect dog bin use with walking routes dictating use.	*Jack Bonham/Clerk
RW127	Future location for Snowy's Nursery Cllr Buckley reported she is still awaiting the full report from the school's meeting with the Local Authority. Snowy's is now into year one of a five-year lease. The school site is the favoured site. Richard enquired about the barn on the Hopkins land. This is one possible option. Regarding the Hopkins application it was asked if the reserved matters would be "called in"? The Clerk will try to find out.* Comments so far raised on the RM application are: Footpath from Links Avenue to Highfield is "unmade" and should be enhanced. No Planning Officer has been allocated so no-one to ask if there are any queries.	*Clerk
