Highlights for sharing

1. **Sub-group activities** included monitoring of paths, drainage, benches, car park and surrounding area. Also, Park meetings took place, for example, with Community Payback Supervisor and Deputy Clerk on 28.5.24.
2. **CSP Group met 4.6.24. and points of interest raised were:**
 - a) The Chair apologised for 2 meetings cancelled in April and May. it was acknowledged that the Countryside Park sub-group has been in operation during this time.
 - b) Payback support has been requested and Clerk is arranging the relevant processes.
 - c) It was noted the Recreation & Wellbeing Committee have considered purchasing Countryside Park. A Report has been written and includes some proposed maintenance and management plans. Feedback can be given to the Clerk to collate and pass on to the Recreation & Wellbeing Committee.
 - d) Agreed: The Clerk to create a shared file for the Countryside Park Group on the Council's OneDrive. This will be used to share' and work on, documents, as well as collate information.
 - e) It was noted that French Drains have been approved. Clerk is 'following up' this action.
 - f) 5-year Park Management Plan is progressing.
 - g) Broadland Tree Warden Network Document was received. The Report and conclusion were noted. These will be considered when creating the 5-year Park Management Plan.
It has been noted that there are several trees growing above, and impacting on, the Car Park hedging. Maintenance to be included in the 5-year Park Management Plan.
 - h) Noted: there is a Parish Council Open Day, to include a volunteer's event at Brundall Memorial Hall from 3pm to 9pm on Thursday 18th July 2024.
