Highlights for sharing

CSP Group meeting took place on 27.8.24. Key points of this meeting are as follows:

1. Car park condition - safety and liability. Car Park is extensively used. Surface of car park is becoming worn and bumpy. Noted a user had car tyre damage in Car Park. The Car Park needs repair. PC also needs a sign to say drivers 'enter and park car at own risk'
2. Request up-date on where PC is with maintenance of Countryside Park Benches
3. No countryside park runner representative at meeting. Invite Countryside Park Runner representative to this meeting Park Sign location discussed
4. Pedestrian gate. Concerns expressed by residents about leaving gate open. Gate is a form of security for the back entrance to residence gardens. Further a closed gate acts as an additional safety to stop children and dogs wandering onto the narrow lane. This is an Anglia Water gate and entrance – hence likely to be their decision about gate. Group agreed to keep gate closed
5. Some dog walkers do not use Dog waste Bins
6. Group site meeting: 3.9.24.
7. CSP management strategic plan progressing
8. Next Countryside Park Group meeting: Tuesday 8.10.24.
