PLOT HOLDER HAS RECENTLY REPORTED A PUNCTURE, WHICH HE THINKS WAS AS A RESULT OF THE CARPARK. 2019/20 SAW DISCUSSION AT LMANAGEMENT BUT NOT TAKEN FORWARD. PLEASE COULD BPC RE-VISIT THIS, AND ALSO CONSIDER A PERMANENT SURFACE IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE LANDOWNER.
