Our Priority Setting Meetings are every 3 months. The meeting is conducted on Teams and if you send a request message to our SNT inbox then we can send you the link for the meeting. Anyone is welcome, we can talk about any on-going issues and make plans for future priorities.

The PSM for March 2024 set the areas priorities as ASB – (with the nights becoming lighter we do expect a seasonal rise) and Road Safety.

We are still happy to monitor SAM 2 results from the area so please feel free to send them to our team e mail and we can take a look at where the problem areas are.

Our main locations for speed checks remain Cucumber Lane, Strumpshaw Road and Postwick Road. If the Community Speed Watch would like to double up with the team for some support, then please let us know in advance when you will be conducting checks and we will do our best to come out with them.

The below crime figures are from January 2024 to date. I have been able to research crime specific to Brundall only. I have not categorised it, this gives you a good idea of what sort of things go on in the village! There is nothing that brings any concerns to the public.
