Over the past year we have been doing upgrades to the outside area of the hall. This has been funded by a grant. We have done two of the three things this has included the new fence. Work on an accessible path around the side of the hall to the hall office and upgrading that area to meet current health and safety standards is booked in to start w/c 2nd March. We will also be looking and realigning the slabs on the step on the path that runs down the other side of the hall.

We have had a new door fitted to the room vacated by the parish council.

After the success of 2025 Christmas Fair, the trustees have agreed to run another one this year the date has been fixed as 29th November 2026 and will be run in the same format as the previous one.
