A FIRST FOR BRUNDALL!

The Cancer Community Chest is delighted to have been selected for the King's Award for Voluntary Service 2025. This award is in recognition of all the valuable work done by our volunteers to ensure the success of the Charity. The King's Award is the highest award that is given to a voluntary group and is equivalent to an MBE to an individual.

The Charity was set up in 1996. Its purpose is to help people suffering from serious illnesses with the costs involved in undergoing courses of medical treatment. The obvious example is travelling expenses for chemotherapy, which usually lasts several weeks.

Grants are also made for parents to be near their children in Addenbrookes or specialist London hospitals. In 2025 we made grants of £46,000 to over 100 individuals. This remains our main priority.

When funds are available, we make grants to local organisations for projects. For the Boudicca unit at the NNUH we gave a grant for vouchers for special bras for mastectomy patients and helped with the costs of refurbishing a sitting room. Money was also given for the purchase of diagnostic equipment for prostate cancer.

The Charity relies entirely on donated goods. Sorting the goods and selecting items suitable for sale takes up a lot of the volunteers' time. The volunteers usually work a 'nominal' three-hour shift at the shop at 41The Street, Brundall, which is open from 10am to 4pm Monday to Saturday.

The Trustees are responsible for the management of the shop and the approval of the grants that are made.



Please keep the goods coming but please don't give us any broken or incomplete toys, dirty or damaged clothing as unfortunately disposing of rubbish is expensive.

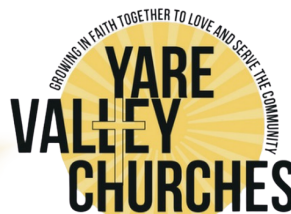
Our community is growing, and we have three trustee vacancies available for anyone interested in helping their community.
