

Responsible Finance Officer's Report 2025-26

The Precept for 2025/26 was £173,820.

Income

The Council received the following grants and donations:

- £2,000 from Veolia from their Sustainability Fund for the creation of a pond at the Countryside Park
- £4,500 from Broadland District Council towards the review of the Neighbourhood Plan
- £11,896 from the Football Foundation for the building of the pavilion at the Sports Hub
- £5,000 from Broadland District Council's Future for Nature Fund for the creation of a pond at the Countryside Park
- £800 from Norfolk County Council for repairs to 3 bus shelters and a power washer to keep the Perspex clean on the more open bus shelters
- £1,000 from County Councillor Andrew Proctor's ward grant towards a feasibility study for a second pedestrian crossing on The Street

The Council also received £83,941.06 of Community Infrastructure Levy funds from the following developments in the village:

- 6 Highfield Avenue - £15,092.76
- Brundall Meadows - £63,712.24
- Low Farm Barns - £2,272.29
- Land adjacent to Strumpshaw Road - £2,863.77

Expenditure

The Council invested in the following projects:

- Resurfacing of the skate park at Brundall Memorial Hall - £4,380
- Repairs and improvements to play equipment at Brundall Memorial Hall - £4,332.98
- Installing goal posts on the spare cemetery field - £1,250
- Replacement of the safety matting under the play equipment at Meadow View - £6,165.85
- Repair of the boardwalk at Church Fen - £1,720

Land in Brundall

- Church Fen
- Cremer's Meadow
- Cucumber Lane Cemetery
- Meadow View Play Area
- The play equipment at Brundall Memorial Hall

Brundall Parish Council leases land for:

Projects for 2026-27

- Improvement of the eastern path at Church Fen

- Creation of a pond at the Countryside Park
- Ensuring the village gateways on Cucumber Lane, Postwick Lane, and Strumpshaw Road are installed
- Complete the review of the Neighbourhood Plan
- Design of Brundall Village Park and appointment of a contractor to undertake the implementation
- Repairs and improvements to the boardwalk at Church Fen with the longer term aim to replace it
