15 posts have been purchased and taken to the barn, ready for the henges to be extended. These henges are the places where we drag the cuttings on the Cut and Clear Day on September 16th. They retain the vegetation without it encroaching on the Meadow.

The water quality in the pond seems to be continuing to improve.

Issues you wish Land Management to discuss

I would like to propose that we give the hut a name which might help to deter youngsters trying to enter it and use it inappropriately. I thought something like "Volunteer Cabin" or similar. If it is seen as "owned" by a group, it might help.
