Highlights for sharing

Countryside Park Group meeting took place on Tuesday 16.6. 26.

Brambles to be cleared from around Postwick road pond. Sarah to ask Pay Back assistance.

Discussed: area around Jubilee Trees has been mowed

Car Park maintenance discussed

Orchard maintenance. Decision to locate metal circular Bench to be viewed by CSP Group (to provide view on location). Mowing of grass is recognised as present practise in the Orchard. The Orchard Hedge surrounds at some point need cutting - to height of entrance gate.

Feedback from Groups using the park. Park Run, in documentation given to the Recreation and Well Being Committee, commented on the need to repair the car park (reply at meeting: repair is to take place), wood in the 'travelator', West side of park (reply at meeting: to be left for nature development), Wood at top of overflow car park (reply at meeting: the wood is beyond the overflow car park and is to be used as a nature development area). The overflow car park is no further than the manhole covers for Allotment water pipes. Manhole Covers are not safe to be driven on.

Allotment hedge to be cut at top and outside (early September).

Referred documents to LM: Countryside Park Group Terms of Reference and Agreement between Brundall Parish Council and the Countryside Park Working Group for the use/maintenance of the Countryside Park - as there seems to be duplication within both. There was also a question about whether the Terms of Reference has been agreed (Clerks are now looking into this).

Note of clarification: The following park management documents are referred to by the Countryside Park Group:

1. Countryside Park Management Plan 2026
2. Brundall Community Orchard Plan 2023.
3. Brundall Countryside Park Tree Management Plan, 2023

In addition, there are park user group agreements for example for Park Run and Allotment. Other user documents are in progress. There is also being considered a Countryside Park Group Terms of Reference document and a User Group document.

Countryside Park Benches. Glade bench is not put back (awaiting repair etc.)

Brundall Biodiversity Enhancement Projects and Pond work - Pond is to stay in original position (though size is slightly smaller). Key issue has been to meet Flood risk criteria. Planning application will be submitted to BDC.
