

Flyposting Statement

Flyposting is illegal as detailed in:

- Highways Act 1980
- Town and Country Planning Act 1990
- Anti-Social Behaviour Act 2003
- Clean Neighbourhoods & Environment Act 2005

Flyposting is an anti-social activity defined as:

- The display of advertising for events, services, or other matters, without permission
- The display of other promotional material posted without permission
- On buildings, posts, poles, litter bins, street furniture, in public
- Mainly done by businesses and community groups seeking free advertising

Brundall Parish Council will remove any material that has been flyposted without notice. All removed material will be disposed of.
